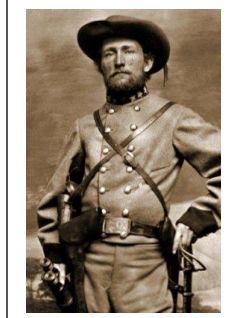


Harrisburg-Hershey Civil War Round Table Field Trips
Riding With the Gray Ghost: Mosby's Confederacy

Please join the **Harrisburg and Hershey Civil War Round Tables** on Saturday, October 29, 2022 as we visit the picturesque rolling hills of the hunt country in Loudoun and Fauquier Counties, Virginia, chasing the ghost of Colonel John S. Mosby, whose Confederate guerrillas employed unconventional and controversial tactics to torment and terrorize their Union adversaries.

This field trip will pick up where our highly successful field trips with Dennis Frye to Harpers Ferry in 2019 and Antietam in 2021 left off. We will visit numerous sites where Mosby's rangers fought and hid, including: Sky Meadows State Park (atop the Blue Ridge, overlooking Paris & Mosby's Confederacy), Mt. Zion Church near Gilbert's Crossroads, Aldie Mill, Middleburg, Rector's Crossroads, Hathaway House (exterior), Ebenezer Churches, Five Points, and a Mosby "safe house."



Recommended reading: The Memoirs of Colonel John S. Mosby. Mosby's Raids in Civil War Northern Virginia, by William S. Connery. Ranger Mosby, by Virgil Carrington Jones. Mosby's Rangers, by James Joseph Williamson (one of Mosby's men).

OUR GUIDES: **Dennis E. Frye** served as Chief Historian at Harpers Ferry National Historical Park for 20 years and earned the Department of Interior's highest honor, the "Distinguished Service Award." Dennis has authored 11 books and 109 articles. Dennis is a nationally known preservationist, having served as a co-founder and past president of both the Civil War Trust and the Save Historic Antietam Foundation. Dennis is a tour guide in demand, leading programs for the Smithsonian, National Geographic, *The New York Times*, and dozens of universities and Civil War organizations. He has also made frequent national television appearances and helped produce Emmy Award-winning programs on John Brown and Antietam. He has addressed more than 150 Civil War Round Tables during his 40 years as a lecturer and battlefield guide. **Richard T. Gillespie** is the past executive director and former education specialist for The Mosby Heritage Area Association. He was a renowned teacher of high school history in Mosby country, teaching for more than 30 years, and was the recipient of Virginia's statewide "History Teacher of the Year" honor. He also worked as a seasonal park ranger at Harpers Ferry, where he commenced his 45-year association with Dennis Frye.
